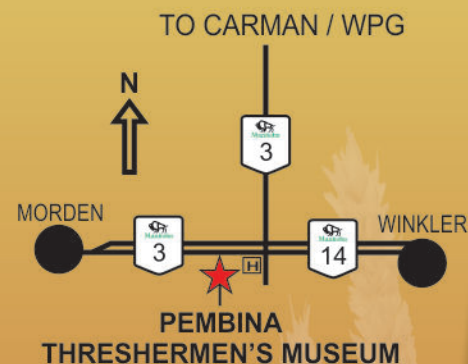

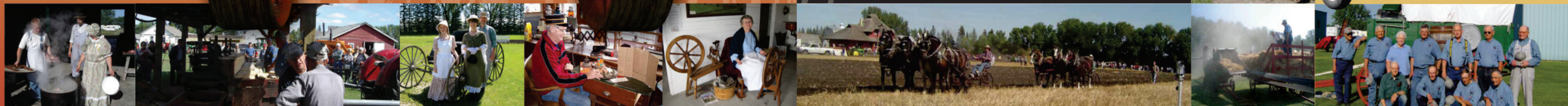

1 Reimer House *
Built in 1878, is a typical Mennonite home moved from the nearby village of Hochfeld. Lived in till 1980.



2 Pelser Barber Shop
Since 1920, replica of the original shop in Winkler.



3 MTS / Post Office
Opened by Manitoba Telephone System in 1948 in Winkler, closed in 1965.



4 Research Station Barn
Built in 1928 in Morden to house the station's Percheron horses, so designed specifically for these horses.



5 Co-op General Store
Moved to museum in 2001, is a store where many sorts of merchandise are sold, but not in separate departments.



6 United Church *
Opened in June 1891 in Roseisle, this church was donated to the museum by the former Roseisle congregation in 1978.



7 Pomeroy Schoolhouse No. 58 *
Built in 1909 near Roland, this is one of the oldest 1-room schools in Manitoba. Closed June 1954.



8 CPR Station *
Built in 1905/6 in Morden, the station was in operation until the late 1960's. The Station Agent's home is upstairs.



9 Blacksmith Shop
Built on site in 1990's, it was the unofficial social centre to catch up on world events & local gossip.

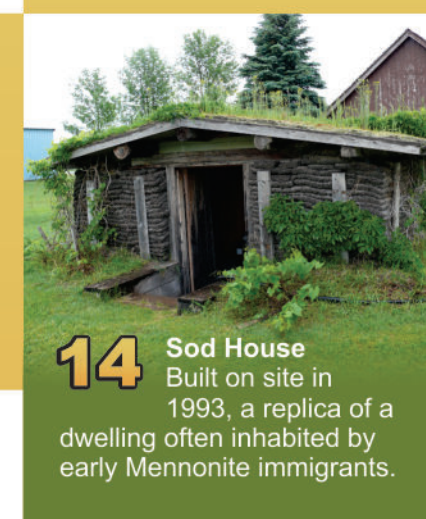
10 Sawmill / Windmill
Built on site in 1990's, the logs for the NWMP Outpost were cut using the sawmill.



11 Small Engines Shed
Shed enclosed in 2010, to house an array of small engines including a Rushton Canadian Elevator Engine.

12 Tractor Sheds
Bldgs 2 & 3, houses the museum's antique tractor collection from Allis Chalmers, JI Case & Cockshutt to McCormick, Minneapolis-Moline & Oliver and more.

13 "Old Stuff A-Z"
Bldg 1, houses hundreds of items from every room in the house, garage & elsewhere; including "The Mennonite" snowmobile made in 1949.

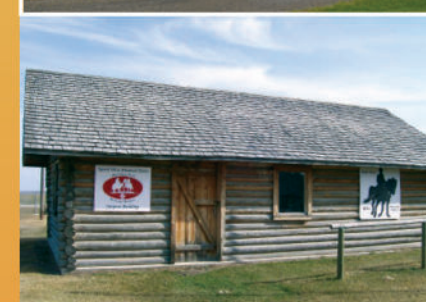


14 Sod House
Built on site in 1993, a replica of a dwelling often inhabited by early Mennonite immigrants.

15 Braun Log House *
Built in 1885 in the Burwalde area, this house illustrates how the north door in the kitchen would have led to the attached barn.



16 NWMP Outpost
Built on site in 2002, a replica of the log outpost buildings from 1874 the NWMP used when they crossed Manitoba
